

29 - Next Steps—The Way Ahead

Action co-ordination groups and management of the Plan

The Parish Council will be asked to formally adopt the Plan as a policy document. In order to take this Action Plan forward, the Parish Council will require substantial input and commitment from other groups and individuals within each village. The Parish Council is keen to co-ordinate the action and has agreed that the best strategy for achieving the Plan is to form a small number of Action Groups who will take on the responsibility of driving forward agreed project proposals and for reporting back to the Parish Council. Action groups will be led by a member of the Council or steering committee and draw in as many volunteers as deemed necessary along with appropriate professional support as required. Consultation will be required with the various agencies concerned such as West Yorkshire Police, Leeds City Council departments, medical practice, Passenger Transport Executive and Ward Councillors

Action groups will be formed for each of the issues identified through the consultation process and the Council will set aside a small budget to cover incidental administration expenses which are likely to be incurred.

An abridged version of the Plan will need to be agreed by the Parish Council for circulation to the residents of both villages in order to acknowledge the contribution made by the residents and to encourage participation in the further development and implementation of the Plan. Continuation of the Parish Council newsletter will also help to keep residents advised of the work being undertaken and to generate further interest in the project.

Supplementary Planning Guidance

Many of the policies and projects in the Plan will need the support and guidance of Leeds City Council and its various departments if they are to be progressed satisfactorily. It is hoped that the objectives, policies and actions which have been identified in this Plan as the views of the electorate of the Parish will be taken fully into account in the future preparation of other organisations Plans and Strategies, particularly those prepared by the Leeds City Council. The foregoing Action Plan is drawn to the attention of the Council's departments and others in order that they might

- + Consider what support and guidance can be given to the Parish Council
- + Consider which policies and sections of the Plan should be explored further with regard to their inclusion in the local development framework and all partnership plans.
- + Pay heed to the recommendations contained in the Plan

Monitoring and review

The Parish Plan will be reviewed annually and updated accordingly. A full review of the Action Plan will take place after three years in order for a new Plan to be developed.
