Please read this information carefully and follow the instructions accurately.
If your application is not fully compliant you risk not receiving a ticket.

Applications can only be made by persons living at an address in **Barwick or Scholes** on 1st May, 2010. This means that over 18's must either be on the electoral roll at that address, or able to prove residence. Proof of residence will also be required for persons between the ages of 13 and 17. There will be a maximum of **two applicants allowed from any one address and only one application per person.**

Tickets are not required for children 12 and under so long as they are accompanied by an adult with a ticket and they should not therefore be included on the form overleaf but will require proof of age on entry to the Festival. **Under 16's must be accompanied by an over 18 on site.**

The names of successful applicants will be printed on the tickets and photo ID will be required to match these names at entry to the event.

It follows from the above that applications cannot be made for anyone not resident, or not able to prove residence, in Barwick or Scholes. Relatives, friends and people who work in Barwick or Scholes but live elsewhere **will not** be allocated tickets.

A limited number of reduced price tickets have been made available to Parish residents at £40 each and will be valid for all days of the event. A limited number of car park passes will also be available upon application, valid from Wed 26 Aug to Mon 31 Aug. You must enclose a **cheque** with your application made payable to **BARWICK in ELMET & SCHOLES PARISH COUNCIL**

Funds raised from the sale of tickets will be used for Community Projects within the Parish of Barwick in Elmet and Scholes.

All applications must be accompanied by a **first class stamped self addressed envelope** which will be used to inform you of the outcome of your application and to return cheques to unsuccessful applicants. Successful applicants over 18 will receive their tickets by hand. Those under 18 will need to be accompanied by the parent or guardian who countersigned the application form. Photographic ID of the Parent/Guardian and proof of the applicant ID will be required.

**The deadline for the receipt of applications is Tuesday 1 June (ballot on Mon 7 June)
Successful applicants will be notified no later than Sat 12 June**

You are requested to include telephone numbers. If there is a problem with your application and you cannot be contacted, your application will be rejected. Last year there were 196 applications for the 50 tickets available which were split evenly between Barwick and Scholes villages.
