We would like to invite you to attend two public exhibitions being held at White Laith Primary School, Naburn Drive, Whinmoor, where indicative plans for the Bramley Fields residential development will be on display.

The exhibitions provide you with the opportunity to see the plans and let us have your feedback, ahead of the submission of an outline planning application to Leeds City Council.

Bramley Fields is being promoted by Persimmon Homes, one of the UK's leading house builders, White Laith Developments and a local land owner. It involves a phased programme over approximately eight years delivering up to 2,000 new homes and supporting facilities on over 200 acres (81 hectares) between the A58 and A64.

The plans will be displayed at exhibitions being held at White Laith Primary School – on Tuesday 24th, Wednesday 25th and Thursday 26th January 2012 and on Tuesday 21st, Wednesday 22nd and Thursday 23rd February 2012. On each day the exhibitions will be open from 4.30pm to 7.30pm.

Representatives from the developers and members of its consultant team will be on hand to answer any questions that you may have.

We hope that you are able to attend and look forward to seeing you and hearing your views.

Following the public exhibitions, the plans for Bramley Fields will be on display at Whinmoor Library in Naburn Approach, on Tuesday 28th February between 1pm and 6pm; Thursday 1st March (9am to 12 noon) Friday 2nd March (1pm to 6pm) and Saturday 3rd March (10am to 12noon).
